The Town of Weston Police Department is currently accepting applications for the positions of:

Weston Police - Patrol Officer – July 19th, 2021

Base salary is reflective of the current union contract (step 1 is currently \$66,670.00 and will increase over a five step pay increase (step 5 is currently \$94,529.00 and will increase per contract). The Town of Weston Police Department contributes and is part of the CMERS pension system.

Physical:

Must have considerable agility and endurance (register <http://www.chip-inc.com> and be able to provide a successfully completed CHIP card to the Weston Police by 5:00 p.m. on September 3rd, 2021¹).

Candidates must pass agility test through CHIP, Inc. A minimum of 20/30 corrected vision in both eyes is required, along with normal hearing. The physical examination will include a screening for use of illegal drugs and controlled substances.

Education:

Must possess an Associate's Degree from an accredited college or university, complete 60 college credits, or have completed two years of full-time active military service with honorable discharge or continued service in the reserve force. Copy of college transcript or diploma, or DD214 must accompany application.

Other:

Applicants must be United States Citizens, and at least 21 years of age, and possess a valid driver's license. Applicants must also expect to successfully pass a psychological, polygraph, background investigation, and interviews.

Submission Process:

All applicants are to have submitted their application to the Weston Police Department in person or by mail (Attn: Chief Edwin Henion, 56 Norfield Road, Weston CT 06883) no later than August 13th, 2021 (5:00 EST) along with a check in the amount of \$50.00 made payable to the Weston Police Department.

Applicants should plan to take a written exam on September 18th, 2021 at the Weston Intermediate School at 10:00 a.m. (bring drivers license for ID verification). A confirmation email will be sent to each applicant once the initial application has been successfully processed.
